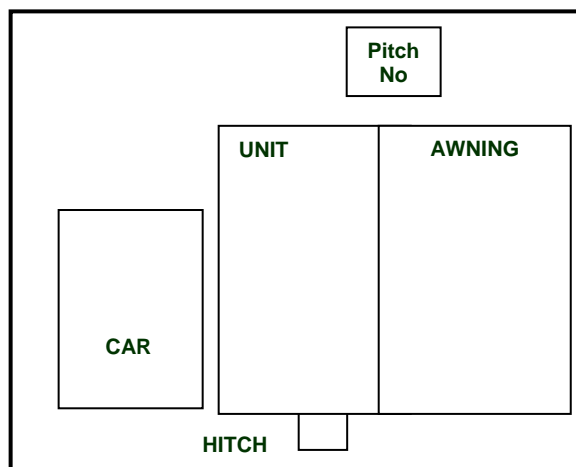


PITCHING INSTRUCTIONS

INCORRECT PITCHING OF YOUR CARAVAN, AWNING, CAR OR TENT CAN CAUSE SEVERE FIRE HAZARDS.

Holiday Parks are required to ensure that they abide by Fire Regulations to ensure a safe environment for guests and surrounding areas. The Fire Authority takes this matter very seriously and are presently carrying out compliance checks within Holiday Parks around the Country. Failure to comply with Fire Safety Regulations could ultimately mean that the site licence issued to Whitemead for moveable dwellings could be revoked. The following instructions have been compiled in line with the Code of Conduct to ensure a safe environment and must be adhered to. Failure to comply will result in a written notification that you are contravening fire regulations and failure to re-site your Camping or Caravanning equipment may result in offenders being requested to leave the property, refusal of further bookings or expulsion from CSMA Club.



You must pitch in line with the above diagram.

- Your pitch is for either; one caravan plus awning and one car, one tent plus car or one motor home plus awning.
- Tents need to pitch central to the pitch number post.
- Pitches must not be occupied by more than six persons.
- Pup tents may be erected in place of an awning but not both.
- You may have one windbreak on your pitch provided it is away from the tent or awning sides.
- Caravans must not be sited awning to awning.
- Gazebos are not permitted on the park.
- Breathable ground sheets must be used on grass areas at all times.
- Only one car is allowed on a pitch, any additional cars must be left at Reception Car Park.
- If using a Barbeque this must be a minimum of three metres away from any tent or awning.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and not left unattended.
- All pitches must be vacated by 11am on the day of departure, failure may result in financial penalties.

The management has been given complete discretion by Motoring & Leisure Services Ltd, in dealing with unsociable and intolerable behaviour, including inappropriate attire. This may include a requirement for offenders to leave the property. In such circumstances, no refunds or compensation relating to unused accommodation or pitches will be given. The circumstances may also be referred for appropriate further action.

CAMPING & CARAVANNING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Pitches will be available from 2pm on the day of arrival and must be vacated by 11am on the morning of departure.

- Your booking is for one caravan or tent plus one car only. An awning is permitted with your caravan or alternatively a pup tent although only one of these is permitted per pitch. You must not have two tents on one pitch.
- Gazebos are strictly NOT permitted.
- Caravans must NOT be pitched awning to awning as this is against Fire Regulations and you MUST adhere to the pitching instructions.
- Pitches may be occupied by a maximum of six persons.
- Dogs are permitted, to a maximum of 2 dogs per pitch. There is no charge for the first dog, but a £2 a day charge for a second dog applies.
- There is a minimum stay of three nights for all pitches during Bank Holiday periods; this includes Easter, Christmas, New Year, Spring Bank Holiday and August Bank Holiday.
- Minimum of 2 night stay all other weekends.
- A member may book one additional pitch for a non member for a same time stay. Any additional pitches will be charged at non member rate.
- Breathable groundsheets must be used. Tents that have sewn in ground sheets are also accepted.
- Caravans and tents should be pitched as per the pitching instructions issued on arrival and enclosed with your confirmation pack.
- All other terms and conditions apply as per the code of conduct
- Late departure may be available depending on occupancy and the time of year. A charge for late departure may apply.
